

COVID-19 Visitor Guidelines

Trustbridge is committed to protecting the most vulnerable of our community members who are in our care, while maintaining the most open visitation policies possible. Please observe the following visitor guidelines to help protect you, your loved one, other visitors and patients, and our employees from the spread of COVID-19.

1. All visitors will be screened for COVID-19 prior to entering a care center. Those with symptoms, COVID-19 diagnosis within the last 10 days, or known exposure to someone with COVID-19 will not be permitted to enter.
2. All visitors will be provided with a medical-grade surgical mask. Masks must be worn at all times while inside the care center.
3. Please wear your mask so that it covers your entire nose and mouth.
4. Please stay in the room of the patient you are visiting. Common areas are closed at this time.
5. No more than 2 visitors are permitted in a patient room at a time.
6. Children must be at least 2 years old and able to wear a mask to visit.
7. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times while visiting the care center.
8. Please observe the visiting hours posted at each care center.
